Dear Mr. Cook:

Van Chevrolet II, LP dba Van Chevrolet ("Van Chevrolet") is the owner of the trademark VAN CHEVROLET. As you are no doubt aware, Van Chevrolet has used and actively promoted its VAN CHEVROLET mark and has invested considerable time and money establishing exclusive proprietary rights in the trademark for automotive sales, services, and related products and services.

It has come to our attention that you are the registrant of the *vanchevroletsucks.com* domain name, and that you are using this domain name in a manner that unlawfully misappropriates and is dilutive of Van Chevrolet's trademark. Specifically, the *vanchevroletsucks.com* website appears on Google's "sponsored links" under the heading "VAN CHEVROLET." Further, the *vanchevroletsucks.com* website contains advertisements for competing dealerships, and clearly seeks to solicit potential clients for your law firm. This use is clearly designed to intentionally mislead consumers, and constitutes infringement of Van Chevrolet's trademark and unfair competition under federal and state laws.


Van Chevrolet intends to vigorously enforce its trademark rights. Federal and state laws provide numerous remedies for trademark infringement and unfair competition, including injunctive relief, compensatory damages, and the profits of the infringer. Further, where the infringement is intentional (as is clearly the case in this instance), the trademark owner can recover attorneys' fees and possible treble damages.

In view of your infringement of Van Chevrolet's rights, we hereby demand that you provide written assurances on or before December 22, 2006 that you have ceased and will permanently refrain from any further use of the term VAN CHEVROLET or any variation thereof that is likely to cause confusion or dilution.
